3 Side-by-Side assembly

NOTICE

Risk of damage due to colliding doors!

Damage to the appliances if set up Side-by-Side. If you set up two appliances in a specific Side-by-Side arrangement, the door hinges of both appliances are specified from the factory.

Side-by-Side setup: Do not change the door hinge.

As seen from the front, set up the freezer or appliance with the freezing compartment on the left. These appliances are equipped with a side-wall heater on the right hand side to prevent condensation forming.

All fasteners are supplied with the appliance.

Make sure you have the following tools on hand:

- □ Side 10 open-ended spanner (supplied)
- □ Torx[®] 25/20/15 screwdriver
- Cordless screwdriver
- Spirit level

Information on moving the SBS combination:

Before assembly, set the appliances up as close as possible to the final location. The appliances must be accessible on all sides for correct installation.

- □ When moving the appliances after installation, always take hold from the front outer corners. Never press your knee against the side walls or door.
- The easiest way to move the SBS combination is diagonally, by moving the left and right corner in turn. If the combination is positioned exactly in front of the

recess, slide it in straight.



□ If you need to pull the combination back out of the recess, grasp it in the bottom third and pull forward straight.



NOTICE

Moving the SBS combination may result in damage! The assembled SBS combination is heavy. If not moved properly, the appliance may become dented.

Read and follow the moving tips (see above).

▶ Remove all protective films from the housing exterior.

Bottom front of the appliance:

Screw in the outer adjusting feet. The appliances can be moved more easily.

For appliances with lever handle

Push both appliances so that they are approx. 10 mm apart from each other, and they are positioned flush facing forwards.

For appliances with recessed grip

- Push both appliances so that they are approx. 32 mm apart from each other, and they are positioned flush facing forwards.
- Line the appliances up using a spirit level on the top of the appliance.

Top front of the appliance:

- Remove the existing covers.
- Before fitting the top bracket, unscrew both grounding screws Fig. 12 (14).
- Store the grounding screws safely. The screws are needed for the bracket assembly as shown below.

- ▶ Slide the bracket *Fig. 13 (3)* with the spacer between the appliances onto the pins. Loosely screw on the bracket with four screws *Fig. 13 (4)* and the previously unscrewed grounding screws *Fig. 13 (14)* alternately on the right and left.
- ► If necessary: Level out the appliance by laying a spirit level on the top of the appliance.

Bottom front of the appliance:

Remove the existing covers.

▶ If the metal plate *Fig. 14 (1)* is installed, unscrew the metal plate.

Note

If you want to transport the appliance or set it up as an individual appliance, you must re-attach the metal plate.

- ▶ Slide the bracket *Fig. 15 (6)* with the spacer between the appliances and loosely screw on with 4 screws *Fig. 15 (4)*.
- If necessary: Align the appliances.
- Tighten top and bottom screws. Top rear of the appliance:

▶ Slide the bracket *Fig. 16 (7)* with the spacer between the appliances and onto the appliance ceiling with the lugs. Tighten with 2 screws *Fig. 16 (5)*.

Bottom rear of the appliance:

Slide the bracket *Fig. 17 (8)* with the slots over the retainer for the wall spacers.

Note

Holes for the screws must be pre-drilled.

- Mark the position of the holes to be drilled with a pencil.
- Remove the bracket again.

Note

Only drill through the metal plate. Drill depth approx. 1 mm.

▶ Pre-drill the screw holes with a 3 mm bit and deburr.

- Slide the bracket Fig. 19 (8) on once more with the slots over the retainer for the wall spacers.
- ▶ Tighten firmly with 2 screws Fig. 19 (5).

Before fitting the top and front cover strips, push the two bars together over the whole length. The strips can be inserted more easily into the gap. Use a soft cloth to push the strips in to avoid dents in the surface of the cover strips. Press the strips into the gap carefully and evenly in order to achieve an optimum bond.

On the top press the short cover strip Fig. 20 (9) into the horizontal gap.

For appliances with recessed grip

On the top press the short cover strip Fig. 21 (9) into the horizontal gap.

▶ On the front press the long cover strip *Fig. 22 (10)* into the vertical gap. Ensure that the strip rests on the connecting plate.

For appliances with recessed grip





- On the front press the long cover strip Fig. 23 (10) into the vertical gap. Ensure that the strip rests on the connecting plate.
- Take off the protective film from the cover strip.*

Top front of the appliance:

Snap the top cover Fig. 24 (11) onto the still open gap between the two control panel trims. Make sure that the outer sides of the cover form a flush finish with the control panel trims.

Bottom front of the appliance

- Place the bottom cover Fig. 25 (12) onto the bracket from the front Fig. 25 (1), slide it down Fig. 25 (2) and snap it in at the bottom Fig. 25 (3).
- To disassemble the cover, insert a screwdriver at the bottom on the side below the cover and release both lower hooks. The cover can swing out upwards.
- Connect the combination to the power supply. See Installation Guide.
- Appliances with IceMaker or InfinitySpring:
- Connect the appliance to the fixed water connection. See Installation Guide.

NOTICE

Moving the SBS combination may result in damage! The assembled SBS combination is heavy. If not moved properly, the appliance may become dented.

- Read and follow the moving tips (see above).
- Carefully push the SBS combination into the specified position.
- ▶ If necessary, level out the SBS combination using the leveling feet.
- Then prop up the door: Lower outer adjusting feet on the bearing bracket until they are resting on the floor.

The height of the doors can be adjusted on the outer lower bearing brackets:

Open the door to 90°.

▶ To lift the door, unscrew the adjusting foot *Fig. 26 (18)* clockwise using the supplied open-ended spanner *Fig. 26 (2)* until the foot comes into contact with the floor. Then continue turning until the door is adjusted to the right height. When delivered, the bearing pin is completely screwed in.

Fit decorative base trim.*

After you have assembled and straightened out the appliances, the base trims can be fitted at the bottom of the appliances. The base trims are decorative and will not affect the functionality of the appliances.*

For appliances with bottom soft stop mechanism*

► Fasten the base panel in the recess on the bottom of the appliance.*

Note

The base trim must be pushed to a little behind the bearing bracket cover.*

For appliances without bottom soft stop mechanism*

Secure the base trim in the recess at the bottom of the appliance, as shown in the figure.*
