Benefits of the Liebherr wheeled excavators



Maximum mobility

Liebherr wheeled excavators are ideal for sites where a lot of travel is involved. Specially designed undercarriages and travel drives have been developed to cover long distances in short times, both with or without a load. Special load holding valves provide additional safety for travelling with large loads.



Subsoil protection

Rubber tyres mean that damage to the subsoil and high noise pollution are a thing of the past.



Additional uses

Liebherr wheeled excavators require less space to work than crawler excavators in the same weight class. This makes them manoeuvrable, flexible and efficient – characteristics which mean Liebherr machines are ideal for a range of uses and therefore makes them versatile.



Low transport costs

Liebherr wheeled excavators are licensed for use on public roads. As a result of the standard speeder with a maximum speed of 37 km/h, the machines can get to the next site very quickly. This means that no costly logistics is involved.



Great stability

Balanced weight distribution and a heavy counterweight enable Liebherr wheeled excavators to work quickly, fluidly and safely, thus increasing their capacity. An oscillating axle also allows the machine to adjust to uneven terrain giving great stability at all times and retaining horizontal alignment. If a job also requires higher payloads and increased stability, claw and plate outriggers deliver perfect grip.



Automatic digging brake

The automatic digging brake ensures that the manual actuation of the brake pedal is no longer required, thus leading to easier operation of the machine. If the machine is at a standstill the digging brake is automatically applied. Furthermore, the automatic digging brake can be linked with the automatic swing axle lock.
